## The Tropical Storm of September 1810 - Sept. 11-12 Charleston, SC Storm of wind and rain began about Tues. Sept. 11th. The wind increased toward the end of the day, with rain picking up. On Wed., winds very high with rain all day. During the night, winds hauled from NE to SE and increased in violence. Storm abated the next morning. Some damage to the wharves, but all vessels rode out the storm. Some trees blown down. This tropical storm passed inland south and west of Charleston. Damage was not widespread. 140 Miles
