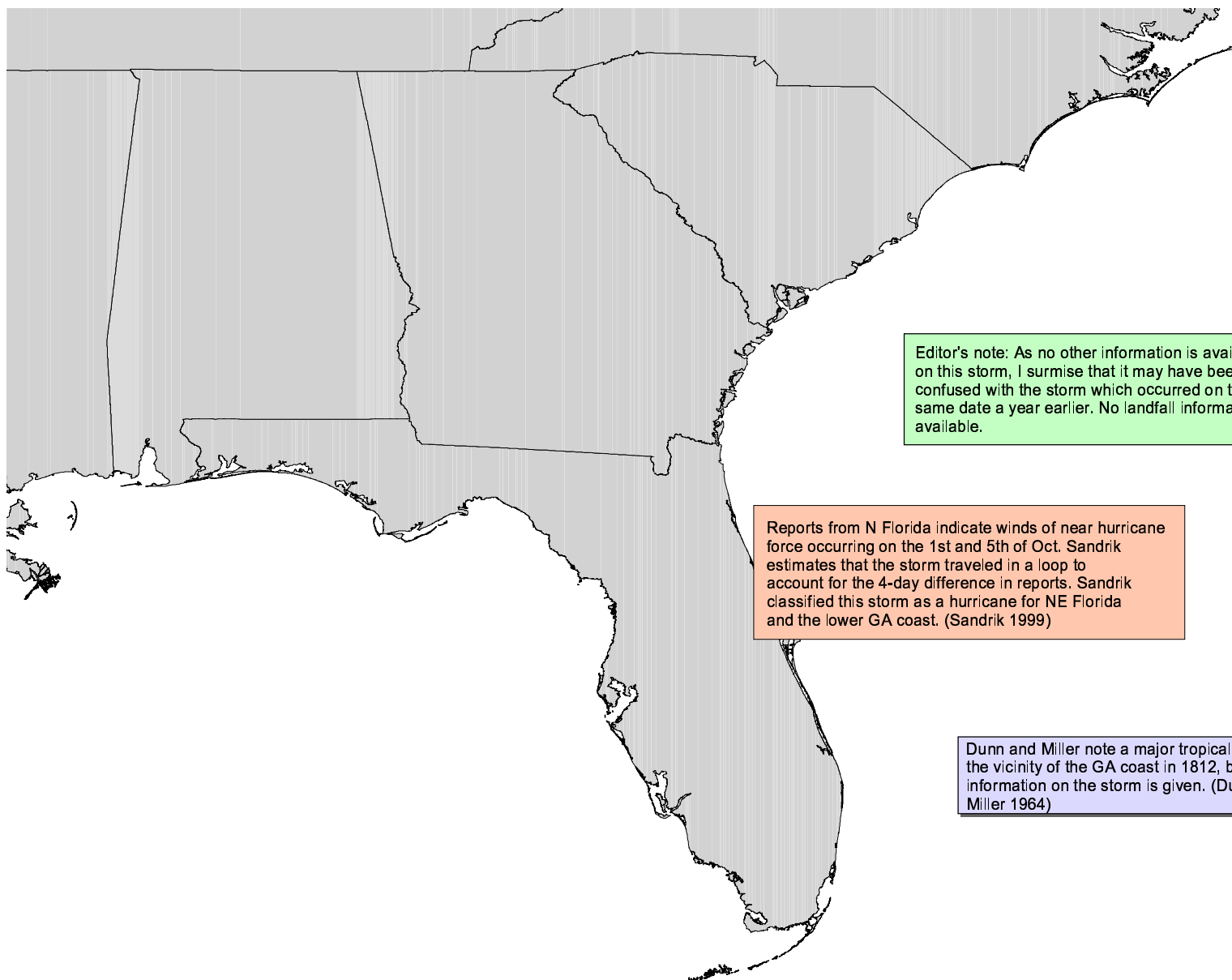


Storm 2 - Oct. 1-5



Editor's note: As no other information is available on this storm, I surmise that it may have been confused with the storm which occurred on this same date a year earlier. No landfall information available.

Reports from N Florida indicate winds of near hurricane force occurring on the 1st and 5th of Oct. Sandrik estimates that the storm traveled in a loop to account for the 4-day difference in reports. Sandrik classified this storm as a hurricane for NE Florida and the lower GA coast. (Sandrik 1999)

Dunn and Miller note a major tropical cyclone in the vicinity of the GA coast in 1812, but no other information on the storm is given. (Dunn and Miller 1964)
