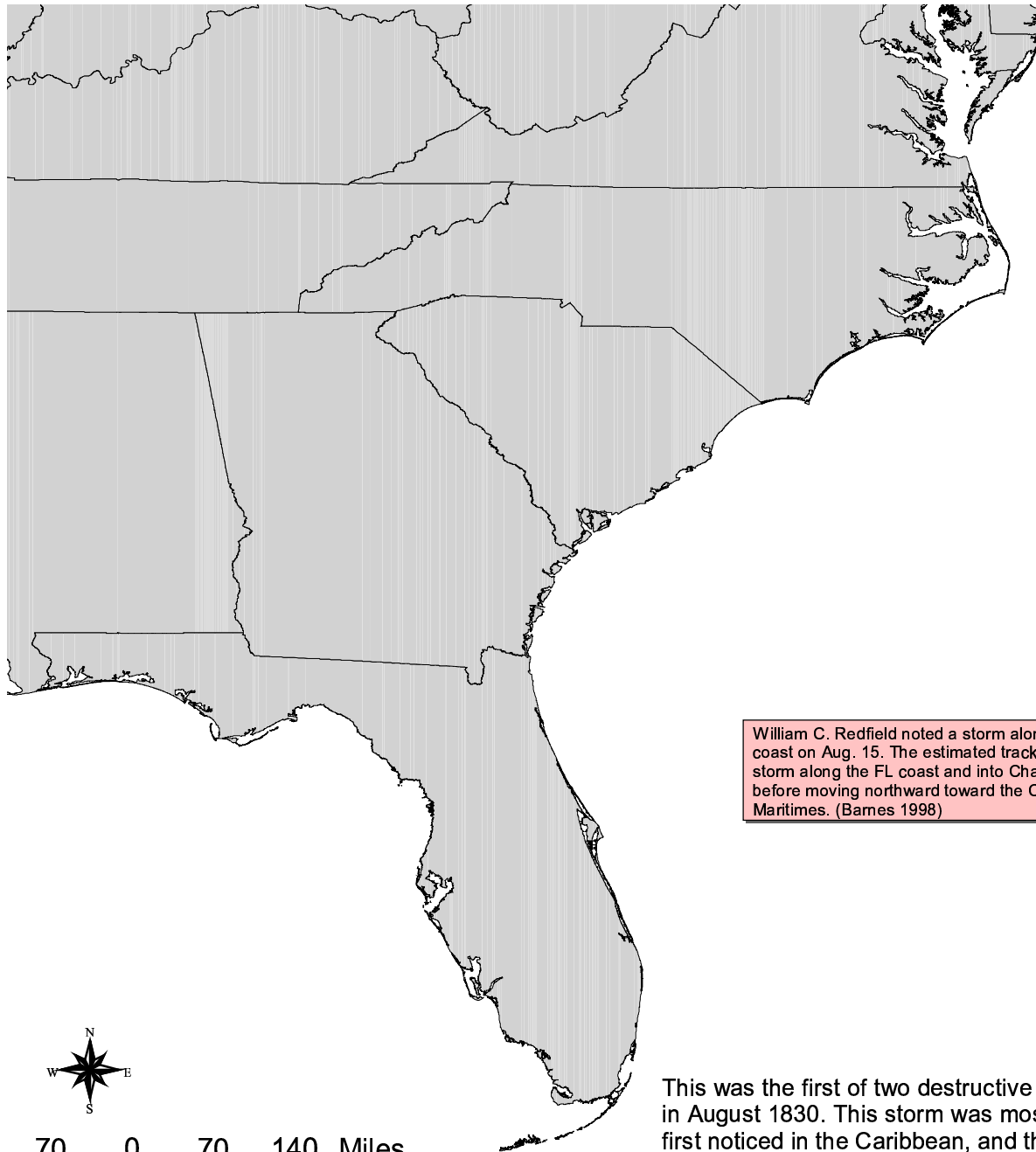
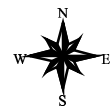


The Twin Atlantic Coast Hurricanes of August, 1830 - I - Part 1



William C. Redfield noted a storm along the FL coast on Aug. 15. The estimated track took the storm along the FL coast and into Charleston, SC, before moving northward toward the Canadian Maritimes. (Barnes 1998)

This was the first of two destructive hurricanes which occurred along the Atlantic seaboard in August 1830. This storm was most intense from Georgia to North Carolina. The storm was first noticed in the Caribbean, and then passed along the Florida and Georgia coasts, before making landfall inside Cape Lookout and Cape Hatteras, NC. The storm then curved to the NE and moved seaward south of Norfolk.
