## Unnamed Tropical Storm - Aug. 28-29, 1831 Fort Jessup (SW of Nachitoches) Heavy rains accompanied by high winds from the NE on Sun. night-Monday Central Louisiana westward to the Sabine Gale raged severely and did considerable damage Lake Borgne - westward Storm raised high tides along Lake Borgne and coastline westward but the main impact of the winds was farther west than the storm in Cotton was ruined by heavy rain and high winds. Baton Rouge Cotton was ruined by the heavy rain and high winds. Had a gale on Sunday night through Monday, the 28-29th of Aug. This unnamed storm swept in from the Gulf about two weeks later than the earlier August storm. It affected areas more westward than the mid-August storm. Ludlum (1963) gives no name to this cyclone 100 Miles but refers to it as a tropical storm.
