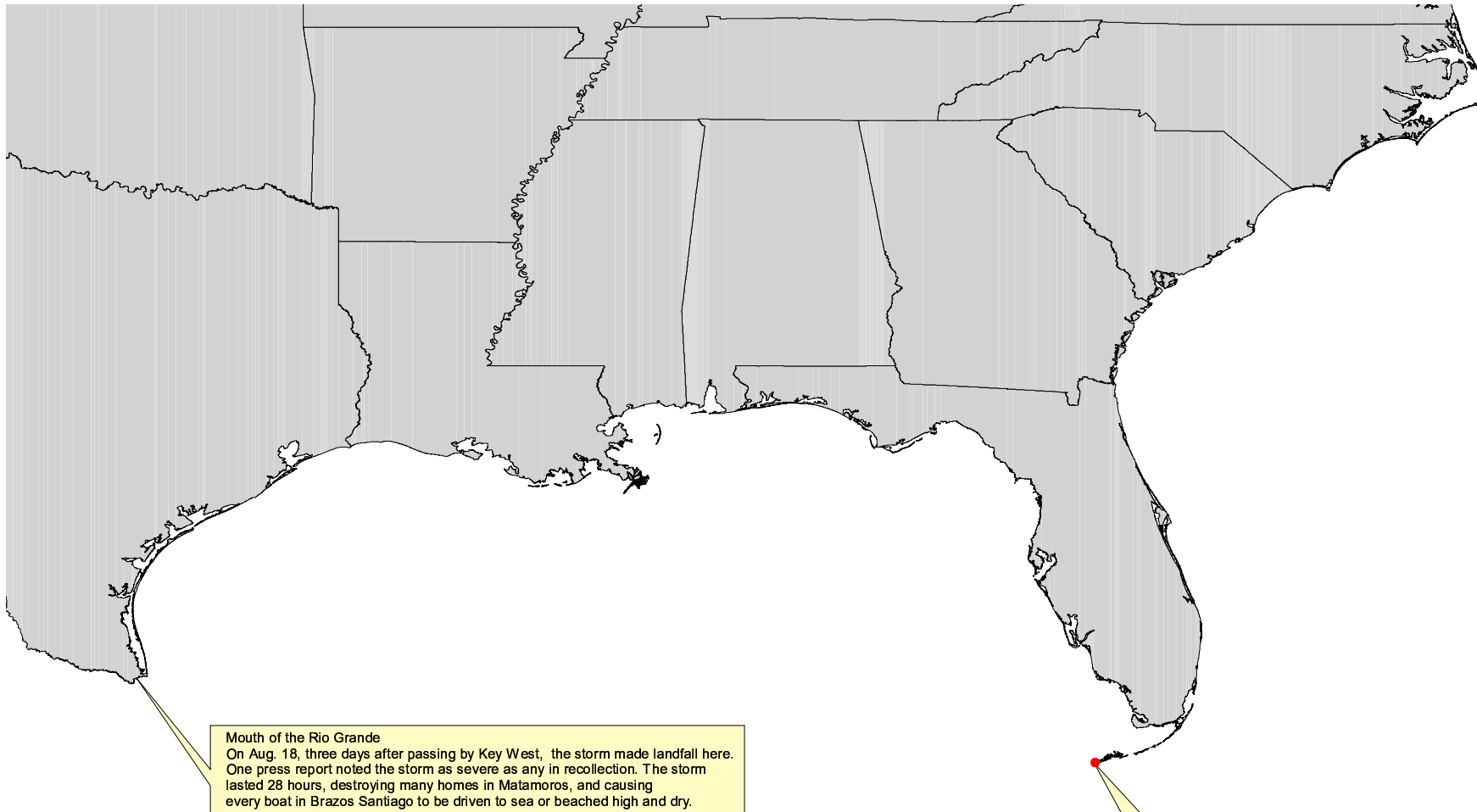


The Antigua-Gulf of Mexico-Rio Grande Hurricane of 1835 - Aug. 15-18



This storm moved out of the eastern Caribbean to affect Puerto Rico, Hispaniola, and Cuba on its way into the Gulf of Mexico. Winds brushed Key West as the center cut across northern Cuba. The storm traversed the Gulf in three days making landfall near the Mexico/U.S. border. The center continued westward without recurring into the mountains of northern Mexico.
