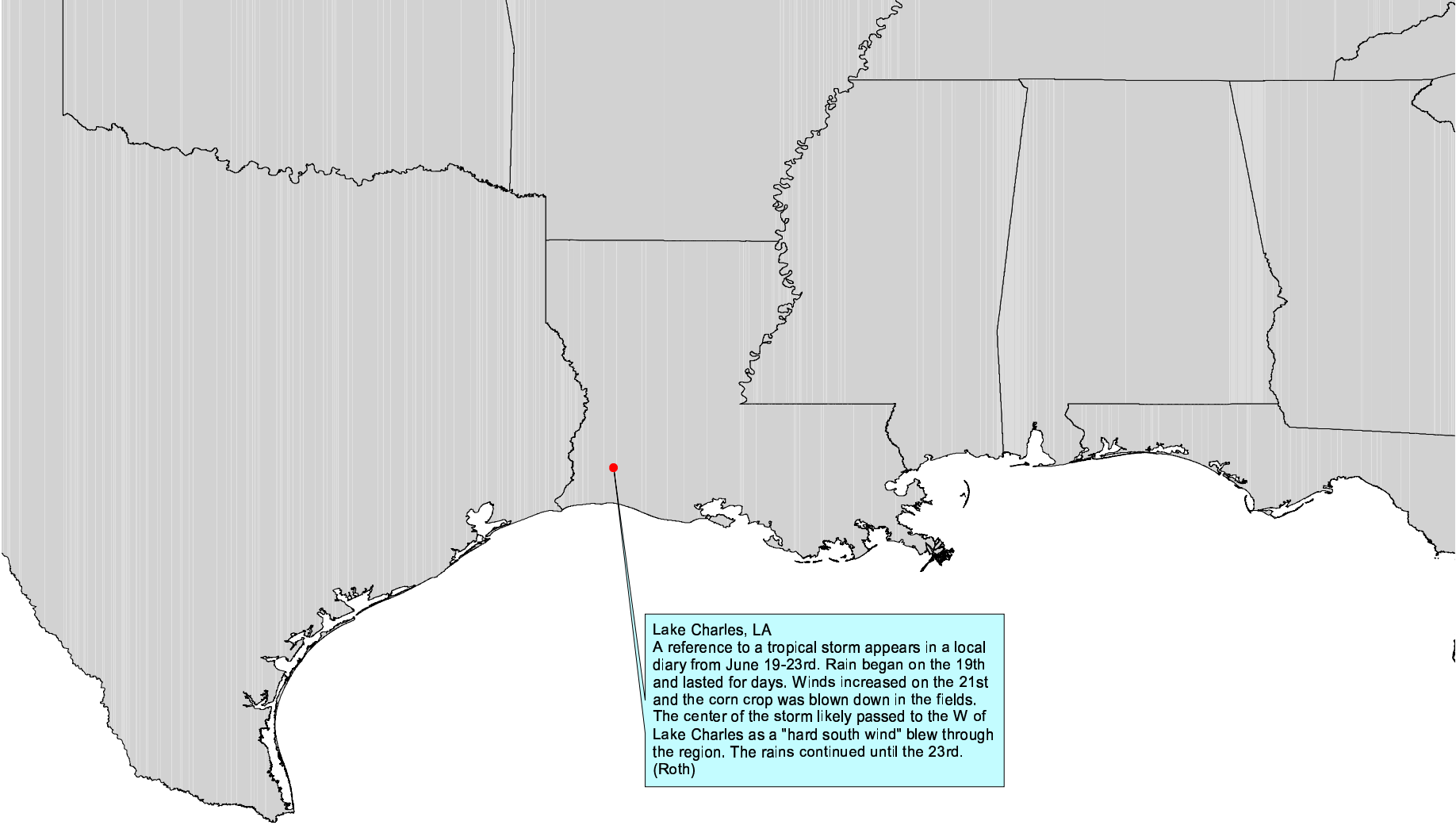


# Storm 1 - June 19-23
