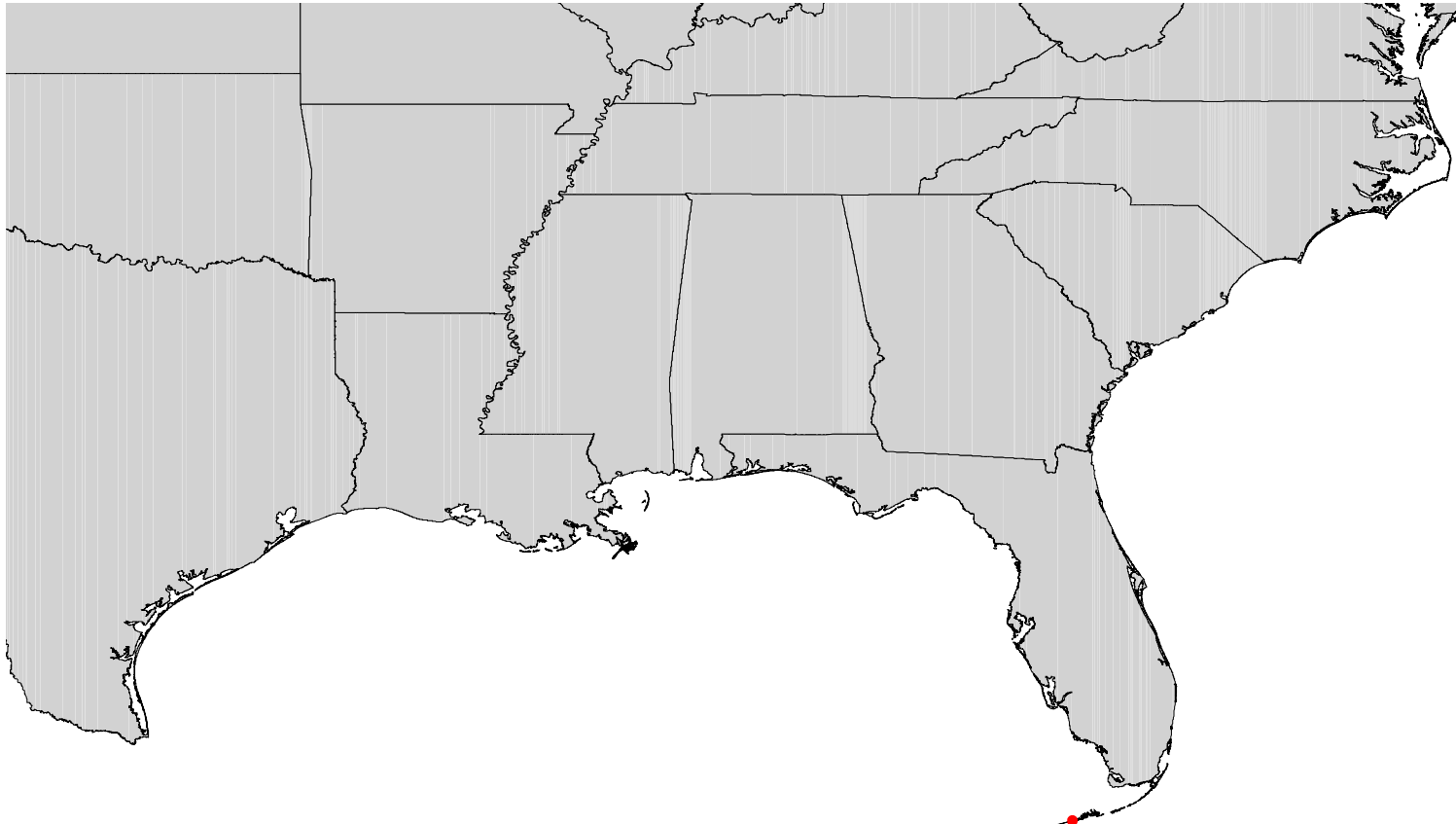


Antje's Hurricane - Aug. 30 - Sept. 8, 1842



Key West struck by "Antje's Storm" on Sept. 4. Little damage to shipping, but some major damage reported to nearby islands, such as Sand Key. (Barnes 1998)

This storm never deviated from a westward path. It passed between Key West and Havana on Sept. 4. In Havana, the storm was considered to be more severe than that in 1821, with a barometric pressure reading of 979.7 mb. The storm moved almost straight westward along the 25 parallel and made landfall in Mexico between Matamoros and Tampico.
