## Galveston Storm - Sept. 17-18, 1842 A strong tropical storm made landfall to the NE of here. Water from the Bay to the N covered the island. The water was as deep as 4 feet. Many smaller buildings were destroyed. Total damage estimated at \$10,000. (Roth)

This tropical storm moved through the northwestern Gulf of Mexico in mid-September, 1842. No major damage to shipping was reported.
