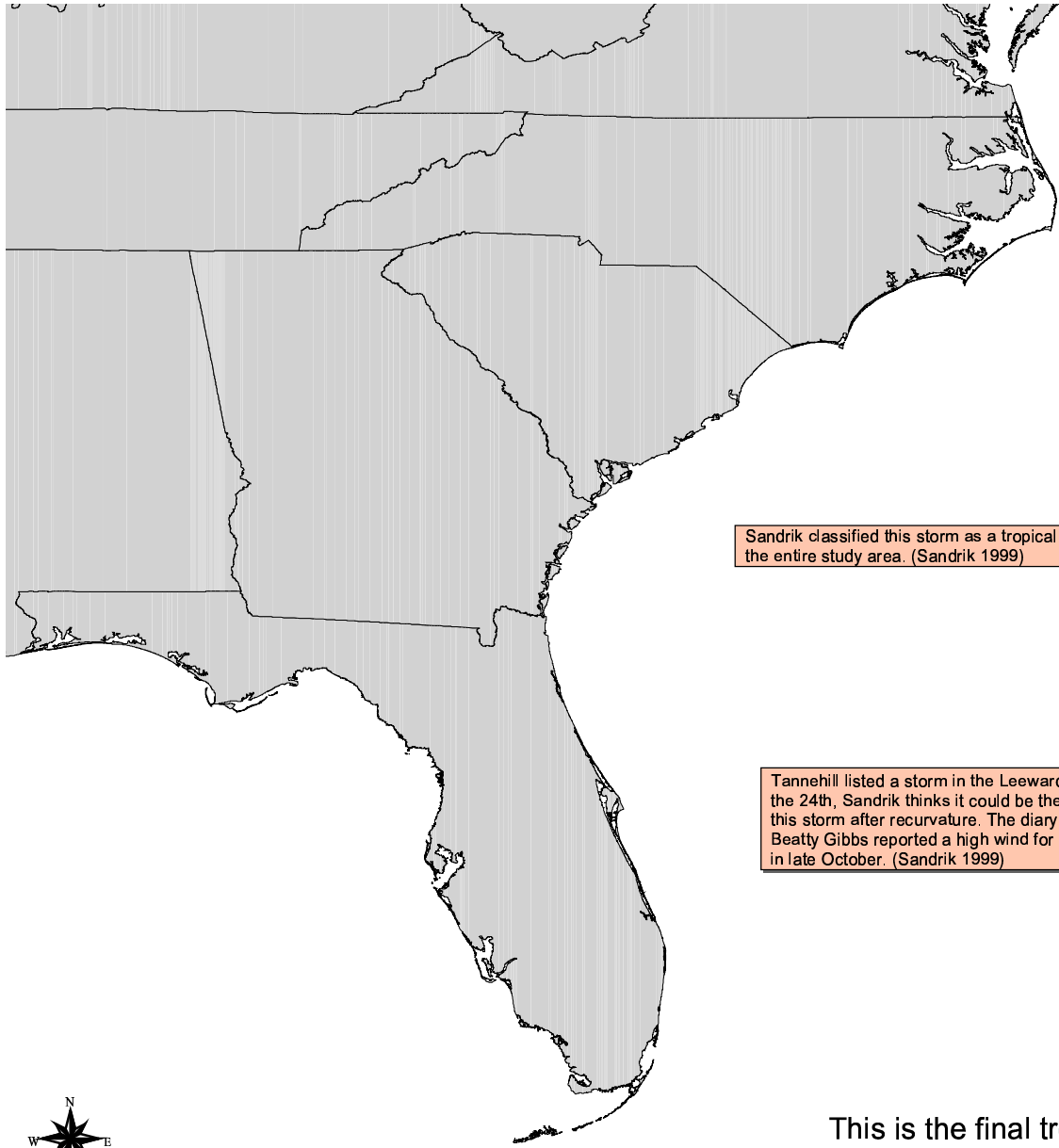
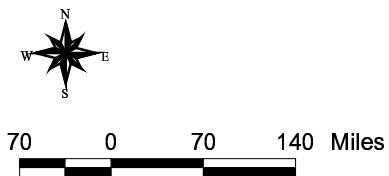


# Atlantic Coast Storm - Oct. 26-30, 1842



Sandrik classified this storm as a tropical storm for the entire study area. (Sandrik 1999)

Tannehill listed a storm in the Leeward Islands on the 24th, Sandrik thinks it could be the same as this storm after recurvature. The diary of Kingsley Beatty Gibbs reported a high wind for a few days in late October. (Sandrik 1999)



This is the final tropical storm of 1842, which occurred along the Atlantic Coast of Florida and the Carolinas in late October. No serious damage was reported in either St. Augustine or Charleston.
