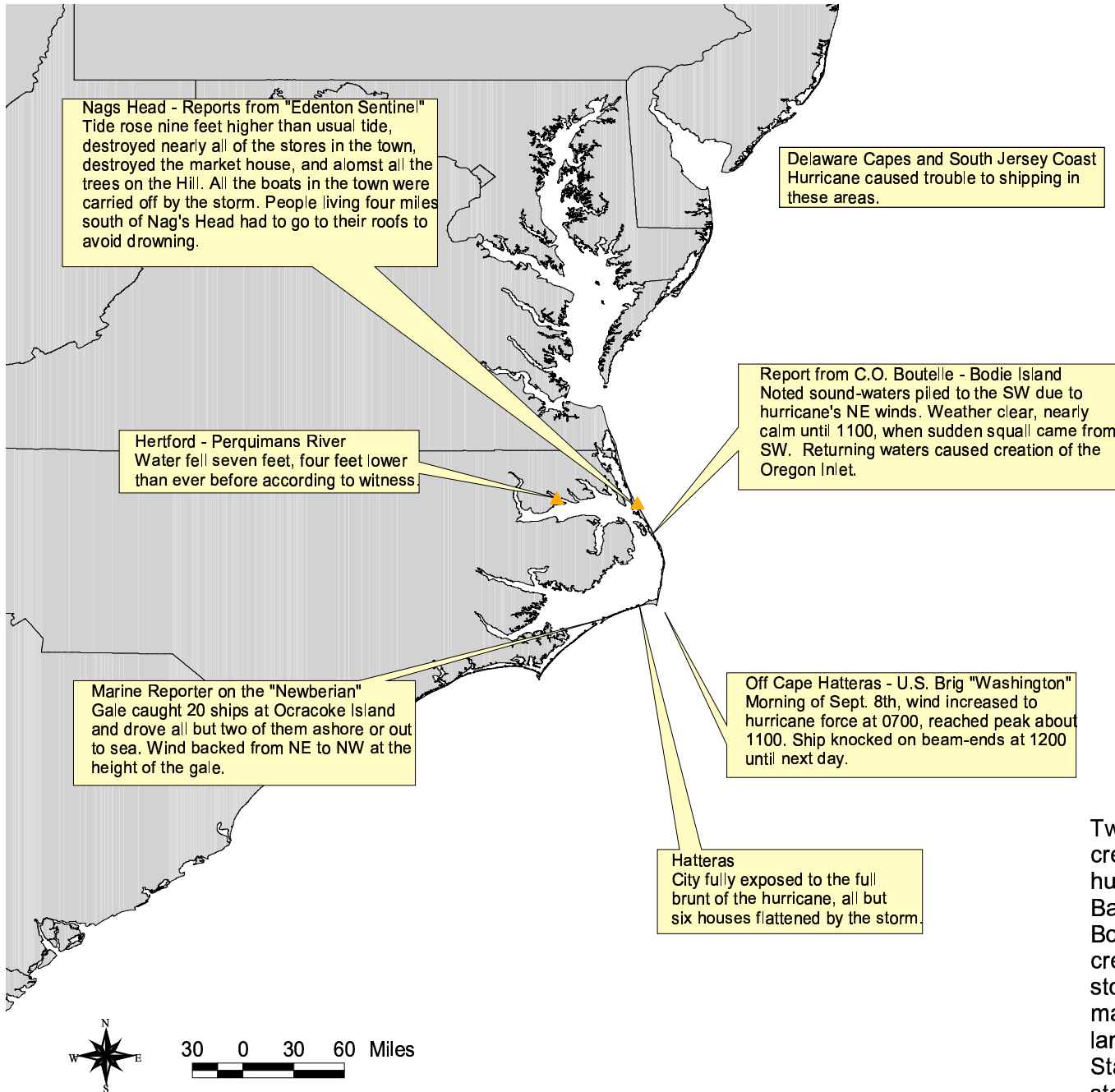


The Hatteras Inlets Hurricane of 1846 - Sept. 8th



Two inlets of major importance were created as a result of this severe hurricane as it moved off the Outer Banks of North Carolina on Sept. 8, 1846. Both Hatteras Inlet and Oregon Inlet were created as a result of this storm. The storm center moved NE offshore without making landfall. There are no reports from land stations in the Middle Atlantic States or New England noting severe storm activity.
