## THE DRAFT

# The best part of the entire season!! Food, fun, & the start of a championship run!!

After all team owners have arrived and settled in, each team owner will choose one of ten envelopes. The contents of the envelope will determine their pick in the draft order as well as their division assignment. The serpentine method will be utilized for the draft. After all team owners have chosen an envelope, some time will be taken so that team owners can trade their draft order number if they choose. This year a *3-minute* time limit will be set for team owners to choose a player. This should expedite the draft and cut the total time of the draft in half.

The draft will consist of 10 rounds, 2 players chosen per round per team. Team rosters will consist of 20 players.

## TEAM LINEUPS

Each team will start the following positions:

1-QB, 2-RB, 3-WR, 1-K and 1-D/ST

Tight Ends can be used in a WR position.

#### **Lineups Due to Commissioner**

No lineups will be accepted after kickoff...if a lineup is not submitted the previous week's lineup is used. Leave your lineup with the Commissioner or Co-Commissioner by phone, e-mail, or paper. It is customary to trade lineups with your opponent of the week. If cannot obtain a lineup contact the Commissioner or Co-Commissioner.

Preferred methods of submitting lineup: email, fax (to Commissioner home phone#), Commissioner home phone leave message – 514-4855.

#### **SCORING SYSTEM**

#### **Touchdowns**

All Positions
49 yards and under – 6 points
50 yards and over – 7 points

### <u>Passing</u>

2 points for every 100 yards passing

## Rushing & Receiving

3 points for every 50 yards

## 2 pt Conversions After TD

2 pt awarded to players as shown in example below: QB passes to WR – QB & WR receive 2 points QB hands off to RB only RB receives 2 points

#### **Kicking**

Field Goals 44 yards and under - 3 points 45 yards and over - 4 points PAT's - 1 point

#### **Defense/Special Teams**

Shutout – 6 points Interception – 2 points Safety – 2 points

You start the player you get points from for the player matter what position they score from. Example: Marshall Faulk is a RB but scores from catching a pass from the WR position...Marshall Faulk gets the points for the TD. Keep this in mind at the draft for those multi-purpose players.

I will have results by Wednesday of each week. If you want to know ahead of time or scores from past weeks contact the Commissioner. The Co-Commissioner will also have this information. Hopefully, scoring errors will be kept at a minimum. If any mistakes are made, missed or wrong scores, let the C or CC know. It will be researched and the corrections will be made. If the error is not brought to the attention of the C or CC before the following Friday that the error is made the scoring will stand as posted.

**CBS.SPORTSLINE.COM** (same as NFL.com) will be used for scoring verification. In the event that this site is down the **ESPN** site will be used.

# **Supplemental Drafts**

There will be 2 supplemental drafts scheduled as follows:

Wednesday - October 1st Wednesday - November 5th

The places are all TBA but team owners will be notified the week prior as to the location of the draft. If you do not show up you do not draft.

Draft order will be determined by W/L record (the team with the most losses drafts first, the second most losses drafts second, etc.) and then by points in case of a tie. If teams are still tied then lady luck is called in and the flip of a coin determines the order.

Each team is allowed to drop up to 3 players from their roster before a player is picked up. Players are chosen from available players (not on any team) and from the pool of dropped players. If a dropped player is not drafted and a team does not choose a player the dropped player automatically returns to their original team.

## <u>TRADES</u>

Another fun part of the Fantasy Football season!!.

#### Real simple:

- > Trades must be finalized the day before the first game of that week in order for players to be used in the lineup for that week.
- ➤ Must be even trades. 3 players for 3 players, 1 player for 1 player, etc.
- ➤ No third party trades teams owners must contact each other directly.
- Trades must be submitted and approved by the Commissioner and Co-Commissioner.
- ➤ If an objection is made to a pending trade by at least 3 team owners the trade will not take place NO DEBATE NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

  Changes can be made and the trade can be resubmitted for review with the same deadlines.
- > No trades to take place after week 12.

## **League Information**

The league will consist of 12 teams in 3 divisions – *Natural, Astroturf, Earthen*. Each team will play all the other teams in their division twice (6 games). The remaining games will be played against teams in the other division. This makes conference games a major factor!! Schedule will be available the following Saturday after the draft.

The season will consist of 14 regular season games. Week 15 & 16 will be used for playoff games and rounds 1 & 2 of the Toilet Bowl. Week 17 is the Championship Game and the final round of the Toilet Bowl.
