

Tallahassee Area Dart Association Handicapped Doubles League Rules

(Established June 2025)

A. Signups

- a. Signups will be posted via the TADA Facebook Page and the signup close date/payment due date will be visibly shared.

B. Handicapping

- a. 3DA's and MPR's of both players on each team will be averaged together to determine a team average.
- b. Team Averages are used to determine handicaps throughout the season
- c. Handicaps will randomly be updated through season and visibly posted in doubles group chat for easy access.
 - i. Randomized Handicap updating helps eliminate sand bagging

C. League Play

- a. One Match will be assigned per week. Typically a round robin is played, where each team plays every other team a full match to determine a seeding (ranking).
- b. Once seeding is determined after the round robin is completed, a knock out bracket will be formed.
- c. If there are multiple divisions it will be noted at the beginning of league via the doubles chat.
 - i. Seeding will be done based by division and the winner of each division will play one another for champion spot.
- d. If a match cannot be played within the week it is assigned, you must inform the league President.

D. Match Play

- a. Teams decided on location, day, and time of play
- b. Failure to communicate and be respectful of other teams time will result in automatic forfeiture for remainder of league.
 - i. This includes scheduling a match and failing to show up
 - ii. This includes scheduling a match and cancelling without ample notice (ample notice means the other team is not at the bar already waiting on you)
 - iii. If an emergency arises you must contact the league President ASAP (example, a car accident on the way to match).

E. Forfeited Teams

- a. If a team is forfeited they will not be refunded any entry fees or be able to participate in playoffs. (This includes teams that can no longer complete the season).
- b. If a team is forfeited all previously played matches will be erased or voided if playoffs have not started.
 - i. If all regular league play matches have been completed prior to forfeiture, the team forfeiting will automatically lose their game that is assigned in the post season playoffs, advancing their opponent automatically.

F. Match Format

- a. Match Format, including corking, will be provided at the beginning of league in group chat. Match Format can change from season to season.
- b. Match Format for Playoffs will be provided via group chat prior to the start of Playoffs.

G. Payouts

- a. Doubles League is a paid out league
 - i. Payouts totals are typically provided at the beginning of league
 - ii. Payouts are made after the final championship match is complete
 - 1. Payouts can be provided via electronic transfer, check, or cash.
 - a. Cash and Check please allow 5 business days for processing
