

Tallahassee Area Dart Association (TADA)

Code of Conduct

1. Respect and Sportsmanship

- Treat all players, league officials, venue staff, and spectators with courtesy and respect.
- Practice good sportsmanship, whether in victory or defeat.
- Avoid taunting, trash-talking, or any behavior intended to provoke or demean others.

2. Fair Play

- Follow the official rules and formats provided by TADA and ensure fair competition at all times.
- Do not engage in cheating, match-fixing, or any conduct that undermines the integrity of the game.
- Report any disputes or concerns to league officials respectfully and promptly.

3. Alcohol and Conduct

- TADA events are often held in venues that serve alcohol. Please drink responsibly and behave in a manner that reflects positively on the league.
- Excessive intoxication, aggressive behavior, or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.

4. Venue Etiquette

- Show respect to our host venues, including The Hobbit and Corner Pocket Bar & Grill, by following house rules and treating staff with professionalism.
- Keep areas clean and help maintain a positive relationship between TADA and its partners.

5. Inclusivity and Zero Tolerance for Harassment

- TADA is committed to providing an inclusive environment for all, regardless of age, gender, race, orientation, or background.
- Harassment, discrimination, or bullying of any kind is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action, including possible suspension or expulsion from the league.

6. Complaint and Disciplinary Procedures

- Any member who witnesses or experiences a violation of this Code of Conduct is encouraged to report the incident to a league official or board member as soon as possible.
- Complaints can be submitted in person, via email/messenger/text/phone
- The TADA Board will review all complaints confidentially and fairly. Both the complainant and the accused will be given the opportunity to provide statements.
- Based on the severity of the violation, disciplinary actions may include a warning, suspension, or permanent removal from TADA events and membership.
- All decisions made by the TADA Board regarding conduct violations are final unless otherwise stated.
