Fundamentals of FRBR

Functional Requirements for Bibliographic Records: Final Report⁽¹⁾

1. To provide a clearly defined, *structured framework* for relating the data recorded in bibliographic records to the *needs of users*
2. To recommend a basic level of *functionality* for records created by national bibliographic agencies

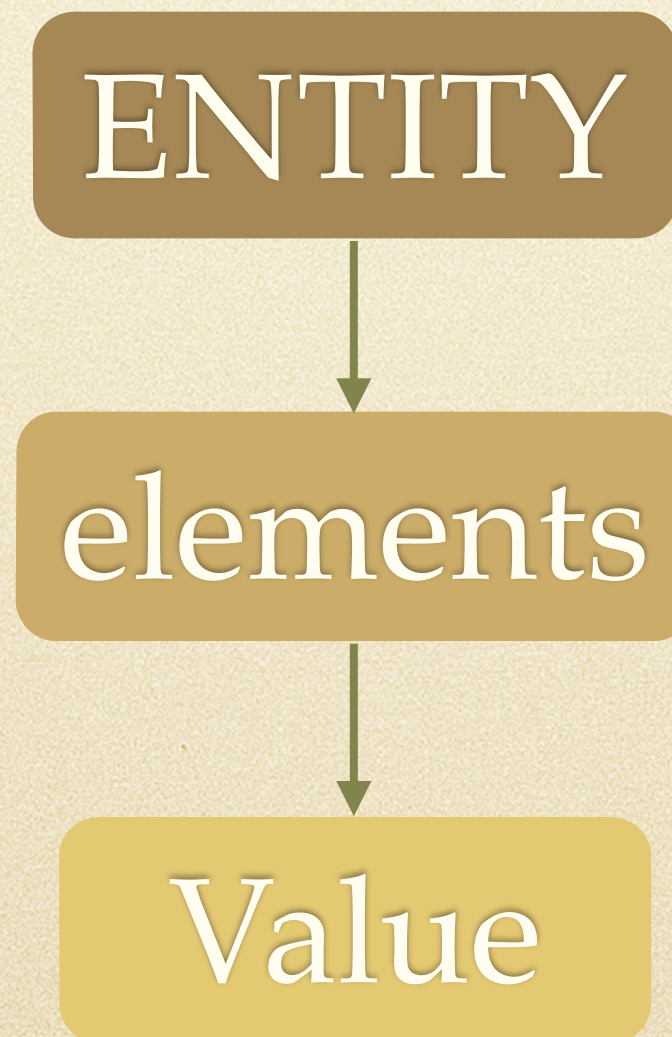

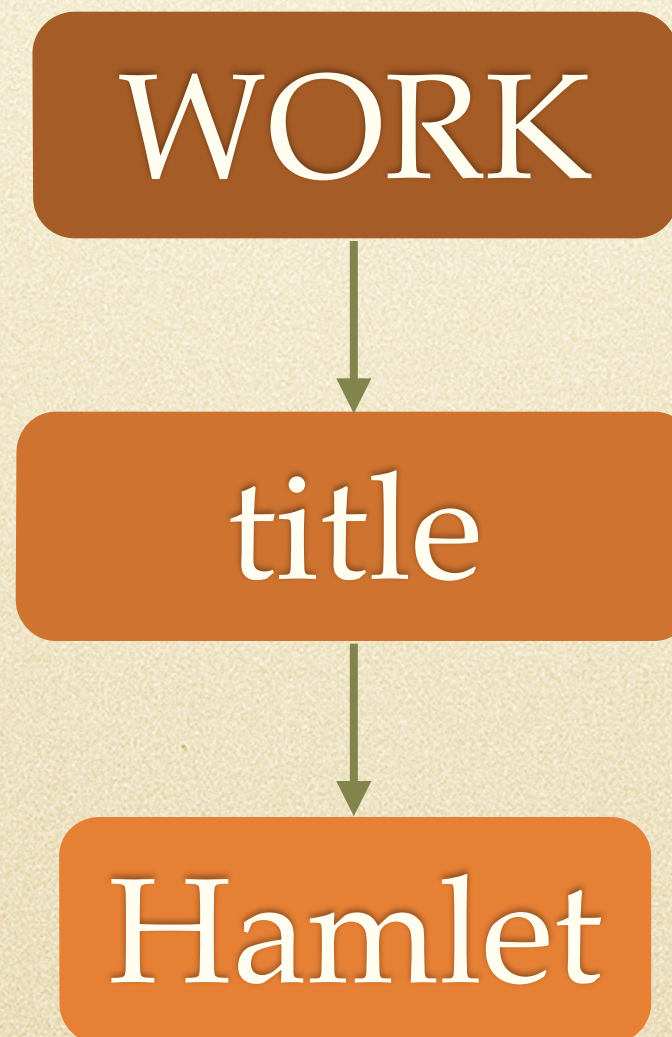

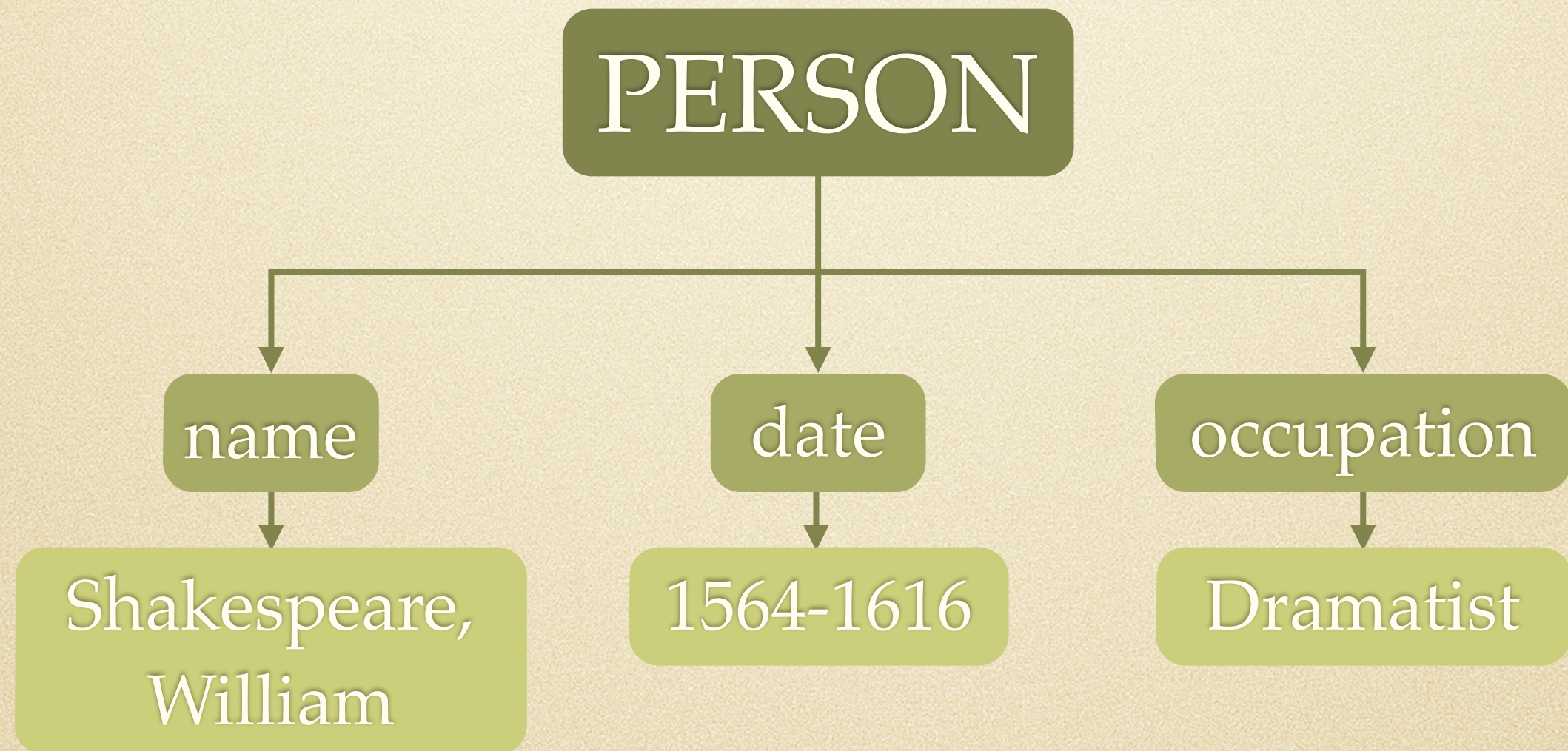

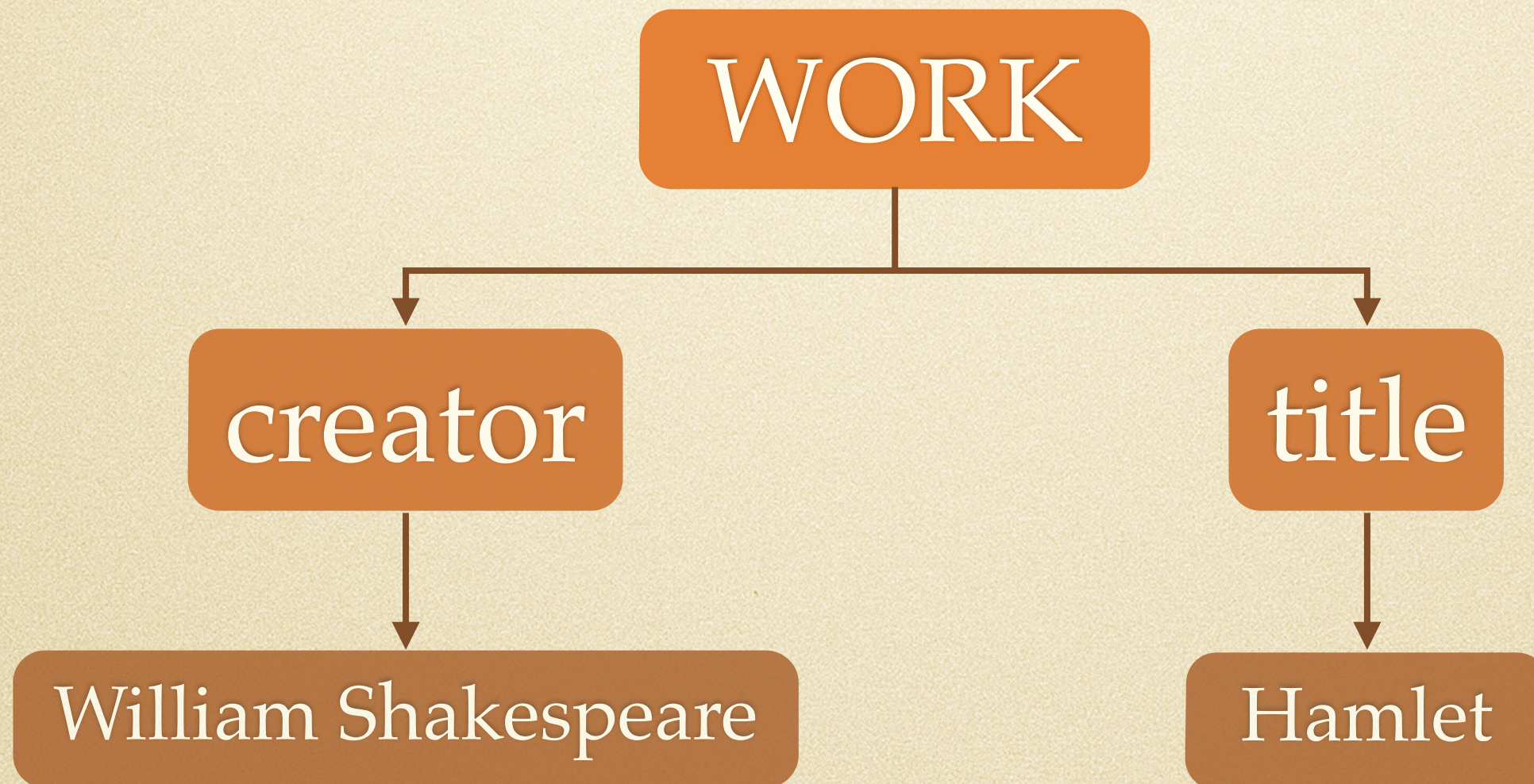

Entity-Relationship Conceptual Model



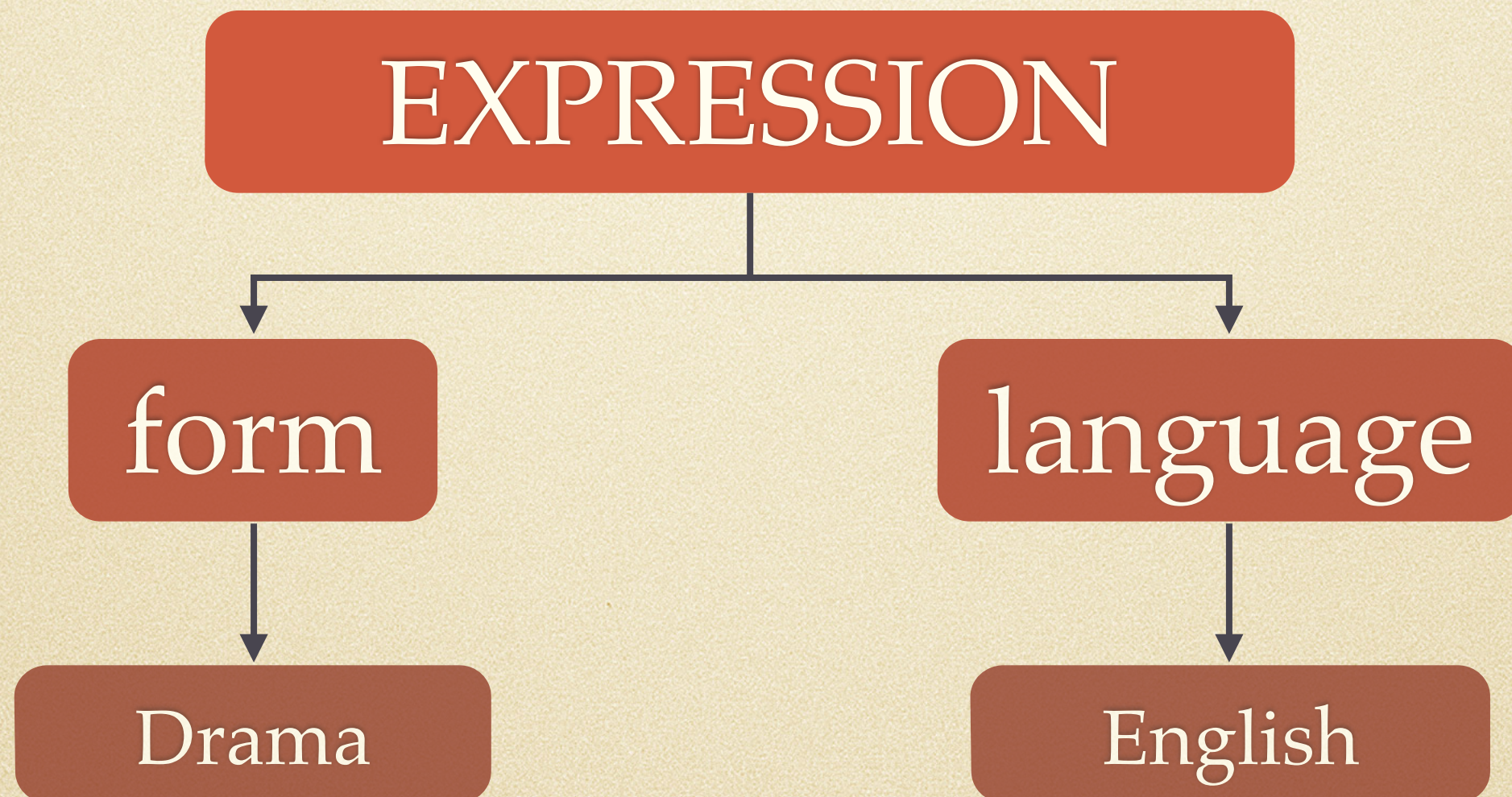

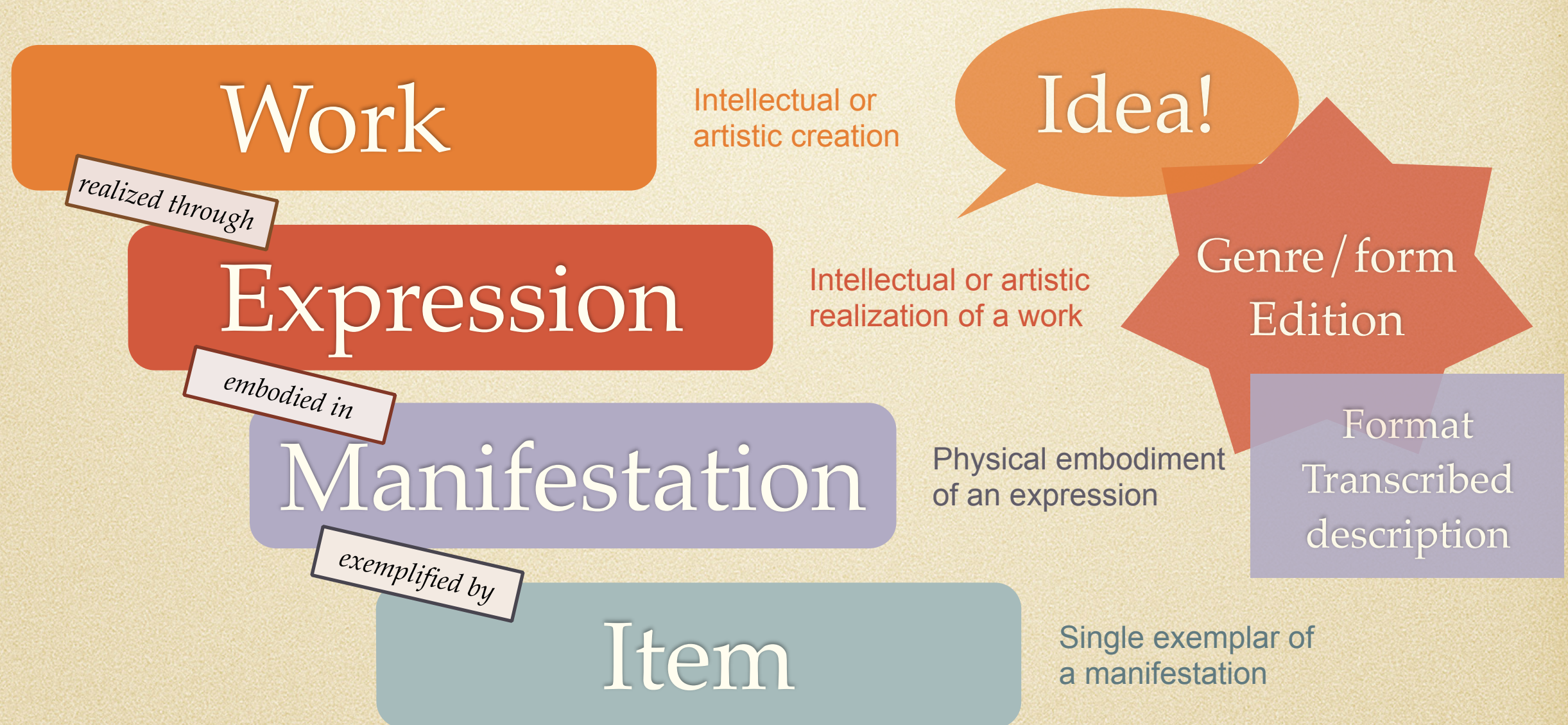

Entity-Relationship Conceptual Model



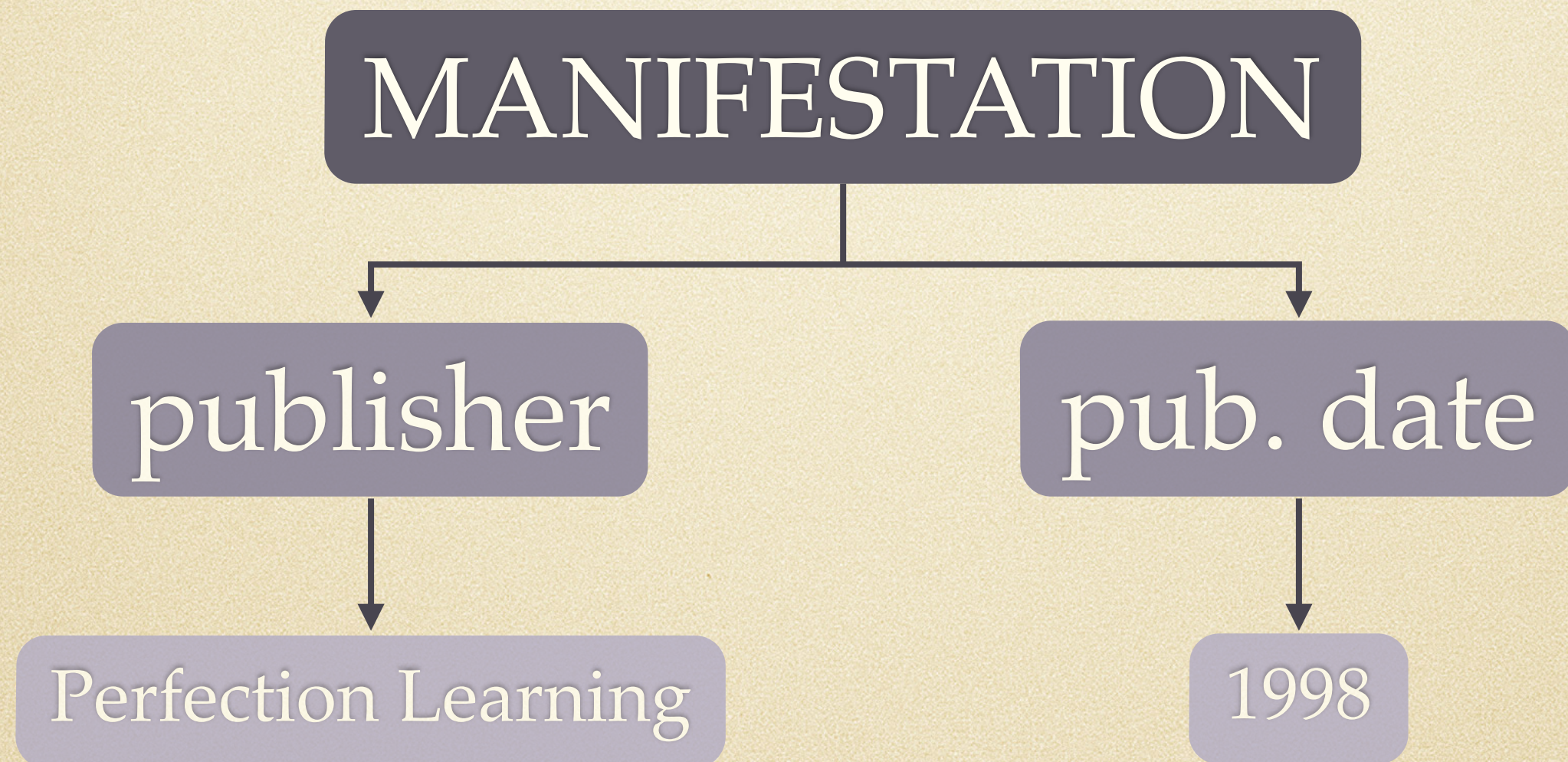
