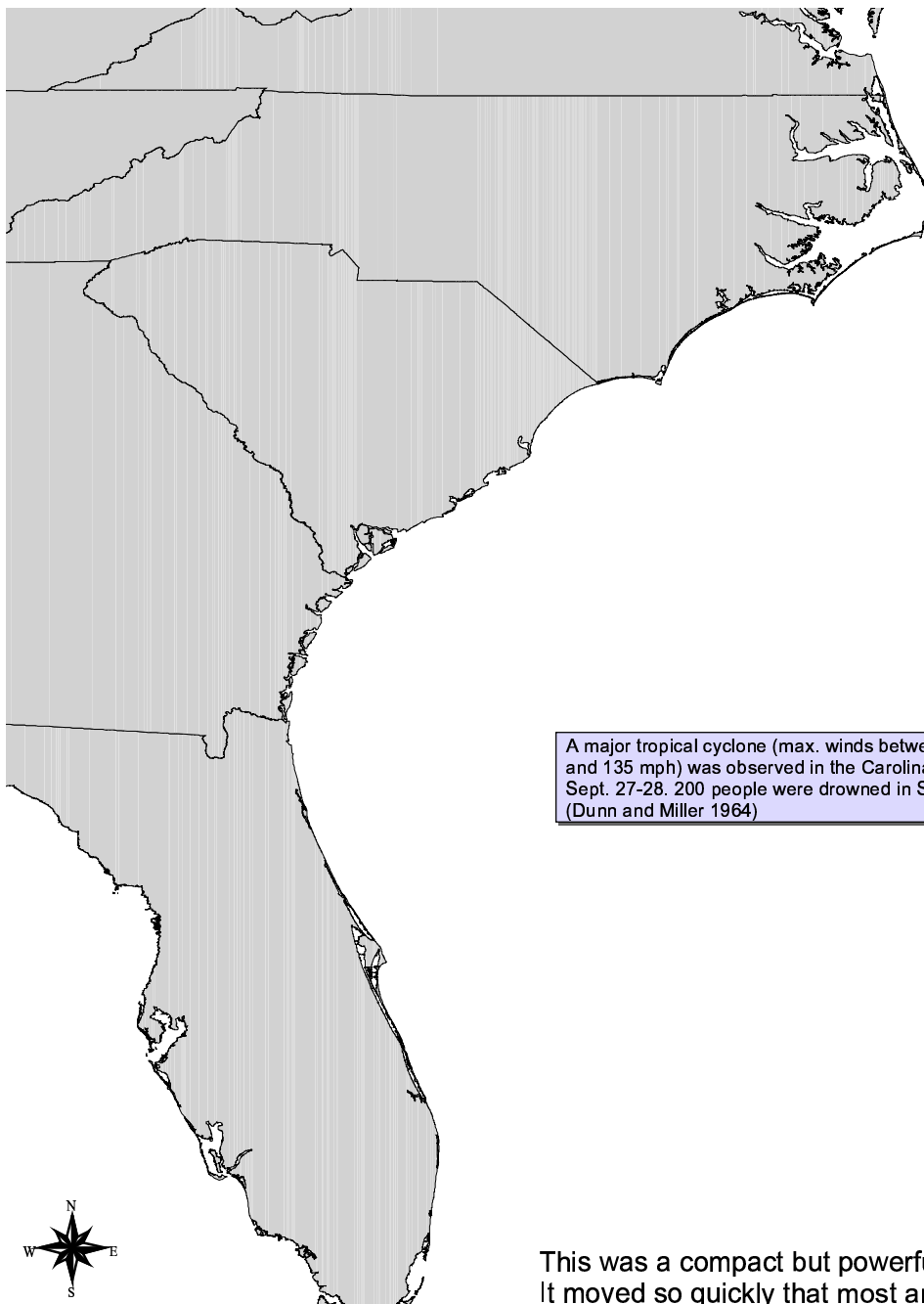


The Memorable Carolina Hurricane of 1822 - Pt. 1 - Sept. 27-28



A major tropical cyclone (max. winds between 101 and 135 mph) was observed in the Carolinas on Sept. 27-28. 200 people were drowned in SC. (Dunn and Miller 1964)

This was a compact but powerful hurricane that made landfall between Charleston and Georgetown. It moved so quickly that most areas experienced hurricane conditions for only four hours. It was the most intense hurricane in the area since 1804. Cape Romain was noted in Ludlum (1963) as the point of landfall.
