## Recycling Can Rings at FSU

### Introduction

Until Fall 2021, Florida State University did not recycle 6-pack and other plastic drink can rings.

The Research Computing Center has partnered with the Center for Information Management and Educational Services (CIMES) and FAMU/FSU College of Engineering Resilient Infrastructure & Disaster Response (RIDER) Center in Sliger Building to serve as a collection center to recycle can rings that would otherwise be sent to the Landfill.

### Procedure

All who wish may package up and campus mail your drink can rings to: FSU Sliger Sustainability Team, Mail Code 2870, at 2035 East Paul Dirac Drive, Tallahassee, Florida 32310.

Will Hill or Mitch Gans will periodically package up FSU's can rings and print a free USPS mailing label from [RingRecycleMe](https://www.ringrecycleme.com) and send them off to be recycled.
