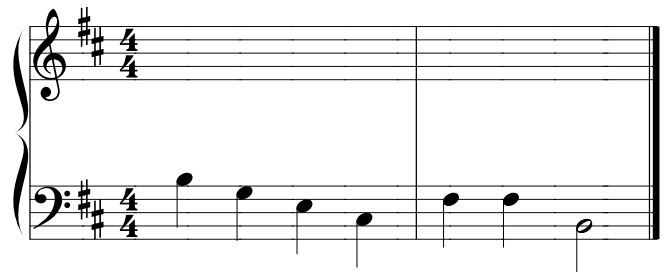
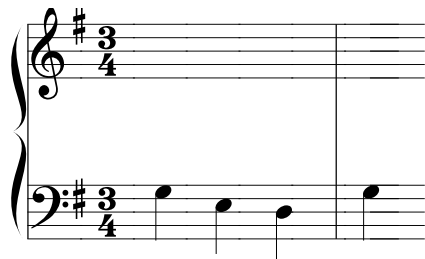
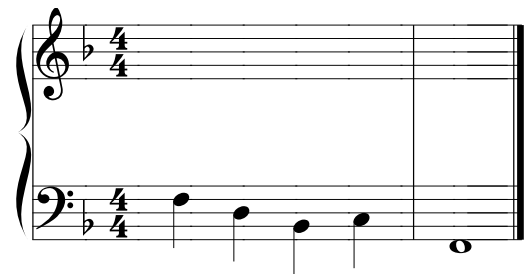
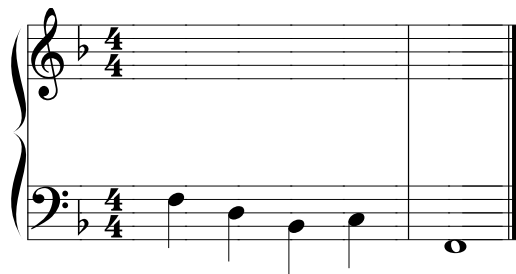


**ASSIGNMENT #9**
